







Dimension Plan

Aerial photo interpretation case 2

- [2004] 1 HKC 119 Kong Sau Ching v Kong Pak Yan & ors
- (SC Leung v Barrett) vehicle road use in 1960s
- "Chances are that the base sheet in 1990 may be the same as in 1960" Tong YC.
 - Reyes J: A new version of a survey sheet did not necessarily revise all details

- Longan tree
 - Prof CY Jim 14.7 yr
 - Mr. Au 30 yr
 - McCoy (Recorder): not more than 30 yr (the age of the tree proves nothing)

- 1998 photo fence detected
- The 2006 survey by Henry Chan using 1:100 (is fairly comparable to & more valuable) that by Andrew Lau of 1:150 in 2002
- Adv Poss D adv poss 3rd party land





- → Aerial photo measurement on roof; not on the ground
