The Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors Annual General Meeting 2021
Inauguration of the New General Council

The Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors (HKIS) was held on 20 December 2021. Sr K K CHIU was elected as the President of HKIS for 2021-2022. Outgoing President Sr Edwin TANG will assume his title as Immediate Past President to continue serving the Institute.

At the AGM, Sr Paul WONG was elected as Senior Vice-President, Sr Francis LAM and Sr Robin LEUNG were both elected as Vice-President, whilst Sr Tony WAN and Sr Raymond KAM were elected as Honorary Secretary and Honorary Treasurer respectively.

The incoming President, Sr K K CHIU, is a Fellow Member of the HKIS. He is the Chief Executive of Greater China at Cushman & Wakefield and has devoted himself to serving the surveying industry over the past 37 years. Since 1999, he has held various positions at the HKIS, including the Chairman of the General Practice Division in 2015-2019, and has made tireless efforts to enhance the professionalism of the surveying industry and to promote land and property valuation. Apart from his service to the HKIS, Sr CHIU also engages in works in various professional organisations and government committees to promote the development of the industry. He is currently a Member of Working Group of Advisory Forum of International Valuation Standards Council (IVSC), General Council Member of the China Institute of Real Estate Appraisers, and Member of Land and Development Advisory Committee (LDAC) appointed by the Government of Hong Kong SAR under Development Bureau etc. In addition, Sr CHIU helps nurturing surveying students in local universities by providing advice to the curriculums and examinations.

The incoming President Sr CHIU said: "As Hong Kong is getting back into its stride after overcoming the social order and pandemic constraints, the Institute will strengthen its role in promoting the wellbeing of the surveying industry leveraging on the tailwind of the numerous large-scale development projects outlined in the Policy Address. Our professional expertise shall play an integral part to build a sustainable city. At the same time, the Institute will strive to enhance the connectivity with its
