(i) CA4229 Land Use Planning and Applied Valuation

Note 2: Students admitted to the programme shall attain not lower than 6.0 IELTS or Level 4 of English modules of the Hong Kong Vocational English Programme (for HKIVE sub-degree graduates) or equivalent University's English Language Enhancement modules (for HK Polytechnic University and City University sub-degree graduates).

Note 3: The abovementioned programme is provisionally approved by the HKIS as a cognate degree programme for admission to the Assessment of Professional Competence ("APC") Scheme under the Building Surveying Division ("BSD"), the General Practice Division ("GPD"), the Property and Facility Management Division ("PFMD"), the Planning and Development Division ("PDD") and the Quantity Surveying Division ("QSD") for a maximum period of FOUR years from 2016 to 2019 intakes. Such approval for all these four intakes will become invalid if the awarding organization cannot fulfill the conditions required by the HKIS.

The provisional accreditation shall apply to the Year 1 students admitted to the Programme from 2016 to 2019 intakes. It shall not cover the direct intake of Year 3 students with advanced standing. The provisional accreditation shall be subject to full accreditation in 2020 or earlier if the conditions required by the HKIS are complied with within the first four years of the provisional accreditation.
